President's Report: Treva Faires reported that David Crump had asked if the board would like for him to resign, since his new job keeps him away from so many meetings. The Board agreed they would like to retain him until a suitable replacement is found. Milli Dold made a motion (it was seconded) that President Treva Faires form a committee to find a new board member to replace David. Treva will select and present a committee at the next board meeting. The board approved motion.

Corresponding Secretary:

- WKC got a Thank You letter from Christy Oberg of the Kansas Humane Society for the gurney WKC donated.
- KSDS sent a letter soliciting donations for their Service Dog training program.
- AKC Breeder Newsletter online
- AKC letter soliciting donations for ACE Awards

Treasurer: Tom Chase presented WKC monthly profit & loss report, balance sheet and report of cash transactions through the month of June 2011.

Conformation Classes: Treva announced she would start a new 6-week series of conformation classes in August—possibly August 11th.

New Business:

- The WKC Board discussed the possibility of holding another AKC sanctioned B Match in September 2011. Board will decide and work out details next month.
- Patti Behrns would like a key to the building so she can work on historical materials. The Board voted to "OK" the release of another key. All old passcodes will be deleted and new ones issued to those authorized to have keys.
- Memorial Fund: Arleen Berry suggested a memorial fund for members who pass away. The funds to be used at the Board's discretion for donation, trophies, etc to honor the deceased club member.
- The Sunflower German Shorthaired Pointer Club would like to hold an AKC sanctioned A match at the WKC building. WKC board voted to OK. The Board discussed holding a "Specialty Match" in conjunction with an All-Breed match.

Sunflower Cluster Shows: WKC Board discussed a possible fourth all-breed show on the Monday after our spring shows. WKC can and will take full responsibility unless another cluster club wants to and is able to carry a full share of the workload (one-third to one-half).

Wichita Kennel Club Board Meeting Minutes July 27, 2011

President's Report: Treva Faires led general discussion of the WDTC comments about holding an agility trial on Monday, April 9th, 2012 of the Sunflower Cluster. Dog Training Club members seemed most concerned with the lack of crating space and interference by spectators. The quality of the arena dirt had been a concern, but it has already been addressed by bringing in all new dirt for the arena in Pavilion I. Mike Williams worked for two days addressing each and every concern by e-mail. (See comments under "Spring Show.")

Treasurer's Report:

- Tom Chase presented WKC monthly Balance Sheet, P&L Statement and Report of Cash Transactions.
- Tom also presented two bills: \$4.38 for newsletter expenses and \$26.79 for a new battery for the WKC building's alarm system. The board voted to pay bills.

Corresponding Secretary:

- NAIA sent letter soliciting funds to help inform the public and influence legislation concerning dog ownership. The WKC Board voted to donate \$25.

B Match: Arleen Berry reported that the September 10th, 2011 B Match had been approved by the AKC. Arleen published a flyer for the event inviting Champions and mixed-breed dogs for exhibition only.

AKC Delegate: Treva Faires reported that she is planning to go to the Eukanuba Show in Orlando, Florida in December at her own expense, but she has offered to stay over an extra day for the delegate's meeting, if WKC would be able to cover the extra night of her hotel. The board voted to pay for the cost of the additional night in her hotel. The "hot" issue at the moment among AKC delegates is Limited Registration.

Building Security: Milli Dold addressed the issue of WKC building keys and pass codes. She handed out a list of the names of people who currently have building keys and pass codes (though the pass codes were not printed on the list). Those who are no longer members and/or no longer need keys will have their pass codes deactivated.

Conformation Classes: Treva Faires will start another set of six conformation classes on Thursday, August 11th, at 7:00 PM through September 22nd. Kim Jennings will assist.

New Business: Milli Dold and Patty Behrens would like to decorate a holiday tree or wreath in the name of WKC (at their own cost, if any). They have many, many small toys they would like to sort on tables in the WKC building. The board vote to let them use the building to do this for Goodwill Industries Festival of Trees.

Memorial Fund: to clarify the newly established (intention to create a) Memorial Fund, Arleen suggested that each time the WKC makes a donation or dedicates a trophy, the membership chairman will cause a letter to be written to the family of the person remembered—so that the family will be aware of the WKC's intent to honor their loved-one. The Board voted to generate these letters.

Fall Show:

- Show Chairman, Mike Williams reminded board members that ads for the fall catalog must be to Onofrio on or before August 1st.
- Fall judging panel has been approved by AKC.
- Treva is in the process of recruiting ring stewards for fall.

July 27 WKC Board Minutes Continued

Spring Show:

- Mike suggested moving the vendors to the south side of Pavilion I and agility crating to the north side. He will talk to Mark Stade and Dianne Hill. This could keep the spectator traffic from going through the agility crating area.
- WKC will be the only club of record on the AKC Show Application regardless of the number of clubs who participate, because only one club can be on the application. Kim Jennings will file the application.
- Monday (April 9th, 2012) show chairman will be Bev Benjes, but a committee will have to be appointed (begged). Kim Jennings will follow up with Bev and possible committee chairs. Treva Faires has volunteered to be hospitality chairperson.
- NO trophies will be given on Monday (April 9th, 2012)—ribbons and rosettes only.
- The number of volunteers needed for Monday (April 9th, 2012) is
 1. 24 ring stewards (12 experienced inside and 12 outside stewards)
 2. 6 people in hospitality from 6:00 AM to 4:00 PM
 3. 2 people who can work the Welcome table and sell catalogs at the north door
 4. 1 crating “czar” as Mark Stade cannot work on Monday
 5. 2 people on the speaker stand during groups
 6. 9 strong people to tear down

Meeting adjourned at 9:23 PM.
