2011 Festival of Trees

WKC will have a tree in the 2011 Festival of Trees sponsored by Goodwill Industries. Our theme is "Toyland". Pattie Behrns made arrangements for WKC to participate in this annual event held on the Exhibition Hall balcony at Century II. The funds raised from the auction of decorated trees, wreaths, etc. provide education, training, employment and personal growth opportunities for people with disabilities and other barriers of employment.

This new project gives WKC visibility in the community as well as participating in public service. Linda LaMar has agreed to serve as chairwoman of the decorating committee. There is no expense to the club, as a friend of the Behrns has donated all of the toys and Goodwill furnishes the tree and lights. Linda, Pattie, Pat Mitchell, and Milli are decorating and providing all other items.

Area organizations sign up to decorate trees, table trees, and wreaths which are displayed and gone over by a panel of judges, then offered to area businesses, etc. at an auction gala. The trees are later bagged and delivered to buyers, so all lights and trim must be securely fastened to the tree. (Pattie has been busy wiring all of the toys. She also works every year on a tree with another organization in which she is active. This year their theme is "The Wizard of Oz".

Wichita Kennel Club Board Meeting Minutes

November 30, 2011

In attendance: Treva Faires, Bev Benjes, Arleen Berry, Pat Deshler, Tom Chase, Mike Williams, Greg LaMar, Diane Kilts, and Kim Jennings

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President, Treva Faires.

October board meeting minutes accepted by WKC Board.

Corresponding Secretary: Pat Deshler received several items by mail and e-mail:

1. An AKC letter informing us that WKC spring shows on Saturday, April 7th, and on Monday, April 9th, 2012 have been approved.
2. A notice of AKC Member dues for WKC.
3. Letter from Kansas 4-H Foundation asking for a donation.
4. E-mail notice from Milli Dold informing WKC members and board about the Festival of Trees in which a tree representing WKC is entered. The trees will be auctioned off for benefit of Goodwill Industries. A huge Thank You to Milli Dold, Patty Behrns, Linda Lamar and Pat Mitchell for taking on this artistic challenge and giving WKC visibility in the community.
5. Solicitation for donation from Take the Lead.
6. Hutchinson Kennel Club newsletter, Bow Wow. Their holiday party is scheduled for December 10th.
7. Kansas Cosmosphere send letter soliciting a donation.
8. AKC Museum of the Dog sent notice membership renewal for WKC. The WKC voted to renew our membership at a cost of \$100.
9. First Monday newsletter from Kansas Humane Society.

Notices: Pat Deshler informed WKC board members that Teresa Burks' mother passed away on Thanksgiving morning. Teresa's address will be published in the WKC newsletters so that members can send condolences.

Treva Faires informed WKC board members that Jo Caliendo was still in Wesley Hospital ICU (since October 30th). It is hoped she will be moved to a regular room soon. Flowers can be sent at that time.

AKC Delegate: Treva Faires informed the board that according to new AKC rules, delegates are now allowed to share some delegate communications, and she will be sending information she feels is relevant to WKC to board members, if they wish to read it.

Treva will travel to the December AKC delegates meeting in Orlando, while she is there to see the Eukanuba show. The board voted to send her to the Delegate's meeting in Raleigh, NC in March. Other AKC delegate meetings will be discussed later in the year 2012.

Treasurer: Tom Chase handed out WKC monthly balance sheet, P & L statement and statement of cash transactions. Tom presented one bill for WKC checks in the amount of \$104.37. The board voted to pay the bill.

Tom also reminded the board that two large bills will come due in December; the first half of our property taxes for approximately \$1,500 and our building and liability insurance will be due for approximately \$2,500.

Membership: Treva Faires reported that three prospective members have been invited to the annual holiday party. Only home visits are needed before the full membership votes on them.

Conformation Classes: No classes are going on at this time. Treva said there will possibly be classes in mid-February if there is sufficient interest. Additionally, Treva stated that she wrote a letter to the AKC on Jacque Matson's behalf stating that Jacque had helped teach handling classes at WKC and had also judged fun matches. Jacque needs these references to get her AKC judging license.

New Business: The WKC board discussed possibly reserving show dates at Century II for the spring of 2015 in the event that the Kansas Pavilions are not available. Pat Deshler has spoken to Jacob House by phone and by e-mail. Under direction of the WKC board, Pat will continue a dialogue with Century II to check on prices and deposits and whether there is a penalty for canceling should the Kansas Pavilions or a better alternative be available.

Pursuant to Milli Dold's memo to the WKC board, a committee will be formed to study the feasibility of charging and collecting a parking fee at our spring shows. The new committee will consist of Tom Chase, Mike Williams and Kim Jennings. Each committee member will research some pertinent questions raised in Milli's memo and report back at the December board meeting.

WKC General Membership Meeting Programs: Treva asked board members to come up with fresh ideas for programs. It was decided that members could present programs on breed standards for the breeds they own. Mike Williams and Kim Jennings will present the Dalmatian Breed Standard at the January general membership meeting. Kim and Dane Jennings and Arleen Berry will present a program on Ring Stewarding at the March meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 8:37 PM.

Here is the list of committees and/or positions available to members

ART SHOW at the DOG SHOW.

(In conjunction with the Sunflower Cluster) Prepare annual mailing. Unpacking & identification of Art works, hanging and eventually removing Art work from 1st display, moving to show site and hanging, removing after shows, and repackaging to return to artists.

(Budget: Self funding)

AWARDS DINNER: Plan annual Awards Dinner. The awards go to members who have bred or own a dog that has completed a championship or an AKC performance title.

Committee duties include arrangements (menu, entertainment, program, booklets, etc.) & maintaining an adequate number of club medallions. Two (2) sub-committees (made up of past honorees) determine winners of the Breeder & Service Awards.

(Budget: Printing, postage, program, flowers, meals, plaques, etc.)

BUDGET: Meets at least once during the year & examines past income & expenditures. Considers budget needs for the coming year and presents proposed budget to the WKC Board of Directors in January of each year for approval.

Researches & makes recommendations to the Board as to investing club funds. Normally chaired by the Treasurer.

(Budget: Copy work and postage)

BUILDING MANAGEMENT: Includes sub-committees that oversee Building & Grounds; Landscaping & improvements; Lending Library; Security; Kitchen management & Finance

CONFORMATION CLASSES: Organizes classes, conformation training and / or socialization, to teach ring procedures, etc. Duties include setting fees, printing & mailing registration forms, advertising.

(Budget: Self funding)

EYE CLINCS: Responsible for semi-annual Eye Clinics. Duties include securing building, arranging for the certified Ophthalmologist, setting fees, scheduling workers.

(Budget: Self-funding)

HISTORIAN: Responsible for organizing all WKC records including minutes, show catalogs, photographs, news articles & other information of historical note.

(No Budget)

JUDGES SELECTION: Responsible for hiring judges for our two annual dog shows. Responsibilities include soliciting suggestions from members, researching judge availability, correspondence, assigning judges, completing & mailing judges' contracts. (Budget: Phone, postage, printing.)

LENDING LIBRARY: Responsible for cataloging & maintaining the collection of books & video tapes owned by the WKC, distribution & record keeping of items checked out or loaned to members. (Budget: acquisition of new materials)

LIBRARY PROJECT (Stud Books): Responsible for WKC's stud book collection in the WKC library. Duties include periodic examination of the books and rebinding older

editions when needed. If necessary, advertising nationally for stud books to replace. (Budget: book binding, postage, etc.)

LEGISLATIVE: Made up of representatives to monitor and report to AKC any local legislative initiatives that may affect the interest of our members. Works with Newsletter editor to keep membership informed. (Budget: Phone, postage, copy work, travel to legislative hearings & meetings, where appropriate & approved by the WKC Board)

SEDGWICK COUNTY ANIMAL ADVISORY BOARD:

This position is appointed by the County Commission.

LURE COURSING: Lure coursing is a performance event, which tests the hunting instinct of AKC recognized sighthound breeds and simulates open field coursing of small prey with an artificial lure. This committee is responsible for organizing and conducting AKC coursing test and field trials hosted by the Wichita Kennel Club. The duties of the committee include: setting dates, arranging for sites, securing approval from AKC, hiring judges, printing and mailing premiums and entry forms, obtaining ribbons, arranging equipment and conducting the events.

MATCHES (SANCTIONED): Responsible for setting dates, arranging for sites, securing approval from AKC, hiring judges, printing & mailing entry forms, arranging equipment & overseeing implementation of WKC's matches, accepting entries, setting up rings & management of match. (Budget: Self-funding)

MEMBERSHIP: Greets visitors to WKC meetings, maintains monthly meeting roster, presents new membership applications to the board, & interfaces with Newsletter editor on potential new member's publication. Correspondence and cooperates with Treasurer regarding flowers for illness or memorials in the event of the death of a member or a death in a member's immediate family.

(Budget: Postage, copy work, flowers or memorials)

NEWSLETTER: Compiling & publishing monthly newsletter. Duties include soliciting information, printing, e-mailing, and mailing. Newsletter is used as monthly Membership meeting notice, and should reach members five days prior to meeting date. (Budget: Postage & Printing.)

NOMINATING: This committee, appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Directors, meets to select a slate of officers & Board as prescribed by the By-laws. (No Budget)

PROGRAM: After interfacing with the President and/or the Board (who have set the calendar for the year), arranges for all programs presented at the monthly membership meeting. Duties include selecting topics, finding speakers or films, scheduling programs & informing the Newsletter Editor of upcoming program subjects. (Also follows up in the next newsletter with report on program if not covered as a news item by the Newsletter Editor.) (Budget: Phone, postage, approved program costs, equipment rental.)

PUBLIC EDUCATION COORDINATOR: Arranges with local organizations (schools, hospitals, nursing homes, etc.) to conduct dog-oriented programs. Receives AKC PEC information for club. Duties include selecting members/dogs for visits and organizing the demonstrations and other public events. (Budget: As approved by the Board)

PUBLICITY: Responsible for acquiring publicity for all WKC events, such as matches, special programs, classes, etc. and works with local media to promote WKC. (Show publicity may be handled separately) (Budget: As approved by the Board)

REFERRAL SERVICE: Maintains a printed list of reputable breeders in the immediate & Midwestern areas covering as many AKC breeds as possible. Also maintains a list of national breed clubs & other organizations, addresses & phone numbers which may be helpful to the phone volunteers in serving the public. This committee deals directly with the public & members. Person **MUST** be knowledgeable of various breeds, AKC rules, registration matters, etc. Committee members (on assigned weeks) access the WKC phone recorder & return calls to the public. (Budget: phone bills, copy work, postage.)

REFRESHMENTS: Responsible for providing (at WKC expense) refreshments for all regular meetings. (Budget: Cost of food, soft drinks, coffee & paper supplies)

SEMINARS: Responsible for selected topic(s) and site(s) for educational seminars. Duties include researching topics, speakers, preparing registration forms, processing & mailing & any other pertinent details of the Seminar. (Budget: Self-funded)

SPECIAL MEETINGS: Westminster (Garden Party), Summer picnic, parades, etc. (Budget: As determined by the Board.)

SUPPLIES & EQUIPMENT: This committee is responsible for buying, maintaining & the inventory of office & show equipment owned by the WKC and/or Sunflower Cluster & stored in the WKC building or in the Sunflower Cluster cargo trailer (in storage) or items occasionally stored in individual members homes. This committee also has the responsibility of making recommendations to the Board or Cluster for further purchase of needed equipment & the ordering of same. (Budget: As approved by the Board)

WDTC REPRESENTATIVE: Upon appointment & presentation of letter from the WKC Board stating that such person has been asked to attend the board meetings of the Wichita Dog Training Club. This individual attends WDTC board meetings and reports back to the WKC board at their monthly meetings or by verbal reports to the WKC President. (This is an effort to maximize communications between the two clubs.) (Budget: None)

WORTHY PROJECTS: This committee reviews & researches dog-related organizations/projects which might qualify as recipients of WKC funds so as to further the charter of our organization. The committee makes recommendations to the Board of Directors. (Budget: Yearly sum plus special gifts approved by the Board)

4-H LIAISON: Representatives interface with 4-H organization & meets with 4-H groups as necessary to arrange manpower support for 4-H dog handling classes & competition trophies. (Budget: As approved by the Board)

WEBSITE: Update website on a regular basis. Maintain website with current information and activities of the club. Visit other websites in order to keep the club website current and up to speed. Insure that the website is submitted to all major internet search engines.

SPRING SHOW COMMITTEE:

April - Sunflower Cluster:

Chairman is appointed by the President with Board approval. This committee is in charge of the Annual Spring show, including applying for the AKC approval of show dates & judges, ring stewards, trophies, working with the Cluster coordinator and the other cluster clubs. This committee involves a great deal of work before the show dates as well as the show weekend. They will compile the premium list information, arrange for trophy purchase and donations, local catalog advertising sales, local publicity, etc. This committee is comprised of several smaller sub-committees that deal only with the Wichita show, i.e. ring stewards, trophies, local advertising & publicity, house & grounds, crating, catalog ads, catalog sales, hospitality, security, telephone, speakers stand, etc.

(Budget: Self-Funding)

SUNFLOWER CLUSTER COORDINATOR: The Coordinator is appointed by the President with the Board approval. The coordinator is responsible for the things that affect all four (4) clubs in the Sunflower Cluster, maintaining a good working relationship with the KS Pavilions staff, being sure our dates are reserved well in advance & that all the building arrangements have been made. Is responsible for the appointment of the committees chosen from all four clubs. The list of committees should be presented at the August meeting for approval by the Cluster clubs. The committees include but are not limited to: Judges' liaison, General Facilities (Crating, Building, Grounds & Sanitation), Security & Parking, National Advertising, National Publicity, Cluster Hospitality, Agility Exhibitions, AKC Information Booth, Cluster Vendors or Booths, Breed Seminars & Committee Parking. The Cluster coordinator interfaces with the Art Show at the Dog Show Chairperson, Show Veterinarian, Show Photographer, etc., sets the dates for the Cluster meeting and distributes the agendas for the cluster meetings to the appropriate persons. Submits the portion of the Premium list that deals with Cluster activities and its special events. Cluster committee information as required to the Superintendent in a timely fashion accordingly to our deadlines. (Budget: copy work, postage, supplies for cluster as needed.)

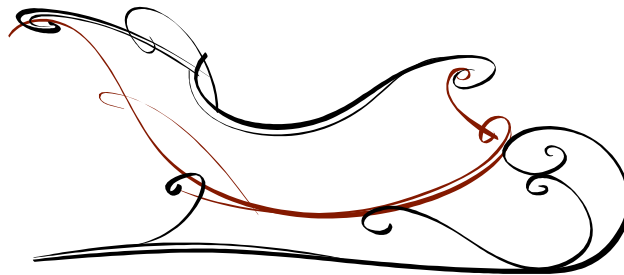
