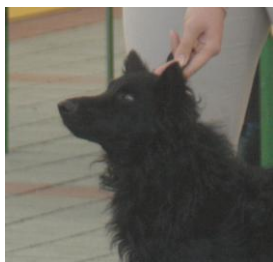

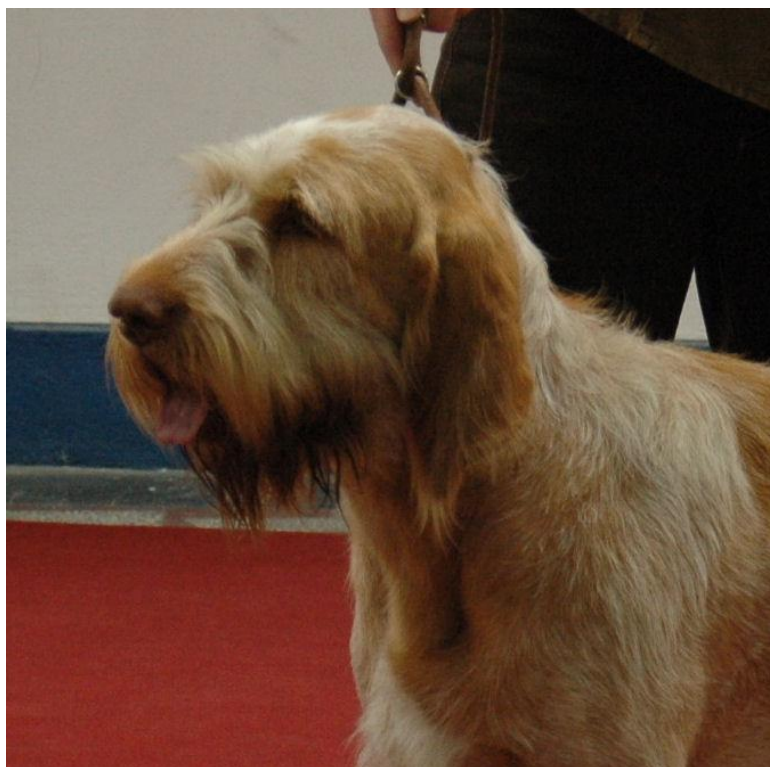
Microchip Clinic Thank You

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Treva Faires, President.

Guests were: Nickie Flynn – West Highland White Terriers, Denise McKee – Bedlington Terriers and Gail Wilson – Chinese Cresteds.

March minutes of General Membership Meeting were approved by the members.

Treasurer: Tom Chase presented a bill for the WKC Newsletter for \$4.90. Membership voted to pay bill. Sunflower Cluster bills and receipts are not yet known.

Corresponding Secretary: Pat Deshler received notice from the Kansas Humane Society that the deadline for "People and their Pets" Calendar is May 6th. The AKC approved WKC for the fall show in Salina.

Conformation Classes: Treva Faires stated that the conformation classes were halfway through for this session of six weeks. There will be more classes in the fall.

AKC Delegate: Treva Faires said she is not going to attend the June Delegate's Meeting in order to save WKC some money.

Art Show at the Dog Show: Pat Deshler stated that art sales were "OK." She also said the 68 ½ people voted for the People's Choice Award for the Portuguese Water Dog. Nobody knows who the "half" voter was.

Herding Instinct Testing reportedly broke even with several Bernese Mountain Dogs participating.

Wichita Kennel Club General Meeting Minutes May 9, 2011

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Treva Faires, President.

Three new members were unanimously voted in! Welcome Amber Applegate, Denise McKee and Gail Wilson.

President: Treva Faires announced to the general membership that the WKC board had voted to withdraw from the fall Wheatland Cluster after the show in October 2011. Letters have already gone out to the cluster club presidents informing them of this decision and asking them to let us know (by August 1st), if they want to keep the judges Milli has retained.

The membership unanimously supported the board's decision to withdraw from the Wheatland Cluster.

Corresponding Secretary: Pat Deshler received a flyer describing the HemaPet Salivary Diagnostic Food Intolerance test. These are available from your vet. It is called Nutra-Scan saliva screening and is for diagnosing food allergies.

Treasurer: Tom Chase presented a bill for newsletter expenses for \$2.41. Treva Faires presented a bill for postage for \$61.49, and Dianne Kilts presented a bill for \$12.00 for refreshments for tonight's meeting. The membership voted to pay the bills.

Tom Chase noted that the final financial report of the Sunflower Cluster show is not yet available, as not all of the bills are in, and there is still a deposit with Onofrio.

WKC will hold a microchip clinic on May 22nd (Sunday) from 1-4 PM. Volunteers are needed.

Art Show: It is mostly wrapped up. Only a few pieces of art have not been returned to the artists due to shipping problems--a few were returned to Pat and Liz.

Conformation Classes: Treva said she may start a new set of classes in August depending on demand.

Fall Show: Volunteers are needed. See Mike Williams.

WKC may hold a fun match in June for a fund-raiser.

AKC Delegate: Treva Faires will not attend the June meeting in order to save the club money. In answer to a member's question, Treva said the 2-5 month conformation classes have been approved by the AKC as a special attraction.

Budget Committee: WKC members will pay for their own meals at the summer cluster meeting. Also, members will be required to supply their own meat at the WKC picnic in September. Bring a side dish to share.

Meeting adjourned at 8:05 PM. The program that followed was presented by Dr. Larry Snyder DVM speaking on stem cell therapy for dogs. It was very good and well received.

Wichita Kennel Club Board Meeting Minutes April 27, 2011

Meeting called to order at 7:02 PM.

Corresponding Secretary: Pat Deshler received a letter from AKC stating that our fall show was approved. She also received an AKC newsletter as well as a letter approving releasing GSDs from our fall show (due to a conflict with their specialty).

Treasurer: Tom Chase handed out WKC balance sheets and P&L statements. He also presented a bill for the trophy gift cards from the spring show for \$1,340. The board voted to pay this bill.

Budget Committee: Trash service at the WKC building has been discontinued. Security alarm service cost has been reduced by the alarm company to keep us as customers. The cost of phone service can be reduced by getting rid of the service "call notes" and the 2nd line. The board discussed the pros and cons of call notes. It was decided that Treva would ask Barbara Gralheer if she would prefer call notes or answering machine for servicing breeder referral.

The budget committee reported that income from the spring show has dropped by \$5,000. So this amount needs to be made up by other fund-raising.

The board discussed having more B matches and/or a 4-6 month Special Attraction at the spring and fall shows. It will be brought up at the general membership meeting(s).

The Microchip Clinic is May 22nd, Sunday, from 1-4 PM at the WKC building.

Art Show: The last piece of art was sent back to the artist tonight. This year's art show made decent money. The unusual piece "Key to My Heart" was donated to the PCA.

The WKC board voted to continue the Art Show at the Dog Show in 2012.

Meeting Programs: Dr. Larry Snyder from the University Bird and Small Animal Clinic in Topeka will give a program on stem cell therapy on Monday May 9th.

Marion Duer will give June's program on canine first aid.

WKC Picnic & Cookout will be a "Bring your own meat" affair in September. We will also bring and exchange sides.

Kim and Dane Jennings will present a program on Ring Stewarding at the September 12th meeting.

Judges: Milli has already hired a few judges for the spring 2012 show including Bart Miller, Kay Strauss, and Dorothy Collier. She will send a letter with more details later.

The board discussed having a "post show" meeting with the management of the Kansas Pavilions to discuss the 2011 and 2012 shows. Treva Faires, Mike Williams, and Kim Jennings will plan to attend.

Among items to discuss with Kansas Pavilions are washing and steam cleaning the floor where the conformation rings are.

The dirt in the agility ring needs to be worked more to keep the agility participants happy. It has been substandard. The board also discussed the possibility of moving agility to the herding building.

Cluster Coordinator will check with Onofrio on the e-mail list for our premium. Where does it go? Nationwide?

The WKC board voted that Milli write a letter to HKC and SKC telling them WKC will not participate in the Wheatland Cluster after 2011.

Meeting called to Order: 7:00 PM

President: Treva reported that Arleen Berry has generously donated \$2,000 to the Wichita Kennel Club "Parking Lot Fund". Also, Treva received a check from Purina for the sponsorship of our spring show.

Treasurer: Tom Chase handed out WKC balance sheet and P&L statement as well as an itemized list of receipts and checks and finally, an accounting of the Microchip Clinic.

Conformation: No classes going on now. Treva may start classes in August.

Membership: WKC voted-in three new members at our last general membership meeting in May. We have two more prospective member finishing up their volunteer activities.

AKC Delegate: Treva will not go to any more delegate meetings this year. Treva did report that the AKC has decided to stop publishing The AKC Gazette (without a delegate vote). The Gazette will go electronic with most of the book, but some parts will be cut completely.

Fall Show: Mike Williams reported that the WKC's part of the premium list is at Onofrio. Deadline for advertising in the Wheatland Cluster Catalog is August 1st.

Mike Williams also reported that the Lure Coursing Equipment belonging to WKC has not sold, but Mike Williams is looking into putting it on E-Bay.

The WKC Board discussed the meeting Kim Jennings and Mike Williams had with management of the Kansas Pavilions a couple weeks ago.

1. KSP will put new sand/dirt in the agility ring.
2. A new shower house is being built at this time.
3. Parking Lot C will be re-paved and striped.
4. KSP would like to quote our catering.
5. The RV Parking section of our Sunflower Cluster premium must be re-worked.
6. KSP can and will steam clean/power wash the Pavilion I floor where the conformation rings are.
7. Carpet for inside the dirt area would cost \$1,000.

Summer "B" Match: Leanne Chase is secretary and Treva Faires is in charge of food. Leanne already has at least one judge.

Meeting adjourned: 8:30 PM.
