All of us have been very concerned with the County Commission's possible sale of the Kansas Pavilions to Mr. Johnny Stevens. Mr. Stevens is a well-known businessman in the Wichita area. Many different rumors have been circulating. Most of the rumors were not what the Wichita Kennel Club wanted to hear or even think about.

Nola Foulston set up a meeting for our board to meet with Mr. Stevens. I want to thank our members who went to represent our Kennel Club. Pat Deshler, Milli Dold, Joe Miller, Dan Caliendo, Tom Chase, Nola Foulston, and Kim Jenning took time out of their busy schedules to attend. They have reported that the meeting could not have been more positive. Mr. Stevens assured everyone he intended to keep the Pavilions open through at least 2016, and probably longer. He stated he had no other plans for the Pavilions! He laid the rumors about using the Kansas Pavilions for cold storage or anything else to rest!

Pat Deshler said, "The meeting could not have been more positive!"

Dan Caliendo echoed the same and added, "If Mr. Stevens can, he made clear he would like to keep the Pavilions functioning as they are "forever"."

Tom Chase said after the meeting, "It will be good to get the Pavilions out of the hands of the County Commissioners with all their political agendas and into the hands of somebody who knows how to run a business."

Milli Dold added, "Mr. Stevens says he expects to lose money the first year or so." She also said Mr. Stevens seemed interested in Wiedeman Park's potential.

Here is the list of committees and/or positions available to members

**ART SHOW at the DOG SHOW.**

(In conjunction with the Sunflower Cluster) Prepare annual mailing. Unpacking & identification of Art works, hanging and eventually removing Art work from 1st display, moving to show site and hanging, removing after shows, and repackaging to return to artists.  
(Budget: Self funding)

**AWARDS DINNER:** Plan annual Awards Dinner. The awards go to members who have bred or own a dog that has completed a championship or an AKC performance title. Committee duties include arrangements (menu, entertainment, program, booklets, etc.) & maintaining an adequate number of club medallions. Two (2) sub-committees (made up of past honorees) determine winners of the Breeder & Service Awards.  
(Budget: Printing, postage, program, flowers, meals, plaques, etc.)

**BUDGET:** Meets at least once during the year & examines past income & expenditures. Considers budget needs for the coming year and presents proposed budget to the WKC Board of Directors in January of each year for approval. Researches & makes recommendations to the Board as to investing club funds. Normally chaired by the Treasurer.  
(Budget: Copy work and postage)

**BUILDING MANAGEMENT:** Includes sub-committees that oversee Building & Grounds; Landscaping & improvements; Lending Library; Security; Kitchen management & Finance

**CONFORMATION CLASSES:** Organizes classes, conformation training and / or socialization, to teach ring procedures, etc. Duties include setting fees, printing & mailing registration forms, advertising.  
(Budget: Self funding)

**EYE CLINICS:** Responsible for semi-annual Eye Clinics. Duties include securing building, arranging for the certified Ophthalmologist, setting fees, scheduling workers.  
(Budget: Self-funding)

**HISTORIAN:** Responsible for organizing all WKC records including minutes, show catalogs, photographs, news articles & other information of historical note.  
(No Budget)

**JUDGES SELECTION:** Responsible for hiring judges for our two annual dog shows. Responsibilities include soliciting suggestions from members, researching judge availability, correspondence, assigning judges, completing & mailing judges' contracts. (Budget: Phone, postage, printing.)

**LENDING LIBRARY:** Responsible for cataloging & maintaining the collection of books & video tapes owned by the WKC, distribution & record keeping of items checked out or loaned to members. (Budget: acquisition of new materials)

**LIBRARY PROJECT (Stud Books):** Responsible for WKC's stud book collection in the WKC library. Duties include periodic examination of the books and rebinding older

editions when needed. If necessary, advertising nationally for stud books to replace. (Budget: book binding, postage, etc.)

**LEGISLATIVE:** Made up of representatives to monitor and report to AKC any local legislative initiatives that may affect the interest of our members. Works with Newsletter editor to keep membership informed. (Budget: Phone, postage, copy work, travel to legislative hearings & meetings, where appropriate & approved by the WKC Board)

**SEDGWICK COUNTY ANIMAL ADVISORY BOARD:**  
This position is appointed by the County Commission.

**LURE COURSING:** Lure coursing is a performance event, which tests the hunting instinct of AKC recognized sighthound breeds and simulates open field coursing of small prey with an artificial lure. This committee is responsible for organizing and conducting AKC coursing test and field trials hosted by the Wichita Kennel Club. The duties of the committee include: setting dates, arranging for sites, securing approval from AKC, hiring judges, printing and mailing premiums and entry forms, obtaining ribbons, arranging equipment and conducting the events.

**MATCHES (SANCTIONED):** Responsible for setting dates, arranging for sites, securing approval from AKC, hiring judges, printing & mailing entry forms, arranging equipment & overseeing implementation of WKC's matches, accepting entries, setting up rings & management of match. (Budget: Self-funding)

**MEMBERSHIP:** Greets visitors to WKC meetings, maintains monthly meeting roster, presents new membership applications to the board, & interfaces with Newsletter editor on potential new member's publication. Correspondence and cooperates with Treasurer regarding flowers for illness or memorials in the event of the death of a member or a death in a member's immediate family.  
(Budget: Postage, copy work, flowers or memorials)

**NEWSLETTER:** Compiling & publishing monthly newsletter. Duties include soliciting information, printing, e-mailing, and mailing. Newsletter is used as monthly Membership meeting notice, and should reach members five days prior to meeting date. (Budget: Postage & Printing.)

**NOMINATING:** This committee, appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Directors, meets to select a slate of officers & Board as prescribed by the By-laws.  
(No Budget)

**PROGRAM:** After interfacing with the President and/or the Board (who have set the calendar for the year), arranges for all programs presented at the monthly membership meeting. Duties include selecting topics, finding speakers or films, scheduling programs & informing the Newsletter Editor of upcoming program subjects. (Also follows up in the next newsletter with report on program if not covered as a news item by the Newsletter Editor.) (Budget: Phone, postage, approved program costs, equipment rental.)

**PUBLIC EDUCATION COORDINATOR:** Arranges with local organizations (schools, hospitals, nursing homes, etc.) to conduct dog-oriented programs. Receives AKC PEC information for club. Duties include selecting members/dogs for visits and organizing the demonstrations and other public events. (Budget: As approved by the Board)

**PUBLICITY:** Responsible for acquiring publicity for all WKC events, such as matches, special programs, classes, etc. and works with local media to promote WKC. (Show publicity may be handled separately) (Budget: As approved by the Board)

**REFERRAL SERVICE:** Maintains a printed list of reputable breeders in the immediate & Midwestern areas covering as many AKC breeds as possible. Also maintains a list of national breed clubs & other organizations, addresses & phone numbers which may be helpful to the phone volunteers in serving the public. This committee deals directly with the public & members. Person MUST be knowledgeable of various breeds, AKC rules, registration matters, etc. Committee members (on assigned weeks) access the WKC phone recorder & return calls to the public. (Budget: phone bills, copy work, postage.)

**REFRESHMENTS:** Responsible for providing (at WKC expense) refreshments for all regular meetings. (Budget: Cost of food, soft drinks, coffee & paper supplies)

**SEMINARS:** Responsible for selected topic(s) and site(s) for educational seminars. Duties include researching topics, speakers, preparing registration forms, processing & mailing & any other pertinent details of the Seminar. (Budget: Self-funded)

**SPECIAL MEETINGS:** Westminster (Garden Party), Summer picnic, parades, etc. (Budget: As determined by the Board.)

**SUPPLIES & EQUIPMENT:** This committee is responsible for buying, maintaining & the inventory of office & show equipment owned by the WKC and/or Sunflower Cluster & stored in the WKC building or in the Sunflower Cluster cargo trailer (in storage) or items occasionally stored in individual members homes. This committee also has the responsibility of making recommendations to the Board or Cluster for further purchase of needed equipment & the ordering of same. (Budget: As approved by the Board)

**WDTC REPRESENTATIVE:** Upon appointment & presentation of letter from the WKC Board stating that such person has been asked to attend the board meetings of the Wichita Dog Training Club. This individual attends WDTC board meetings and reports back to the WKC board at their monthly meetings or by verbal reports to the WKC President. (This is an effort to maximize communications between the two clubs.) (Budget: None)

**WORTHY PROJECTS:** This committee reviews & researches dog-related organizations/projects which might qualify as recipients of WKC funds so as to further the charter of our organization. The committee makes recommendations to the Board of Directors. (Budget: Yearly sum plus special gifts approved by the Board)

**4-H LIAISON:** Representatives interface with 4-H organization & meets with 4-H groups as necessary to arrange manpower support for 4-H dog handling classes & competition trophies. (Budget: As approved by the Board)

**WEBSITE:** Update website on a regular basis. Maintain website with current information and activities of the club. Visit other websites in order to keep the club website current and up to speed. Insure that the website is submitted to all major internet search engines.

#### **SPRING SHOW COMMITTEE:**

April - Sunflower Cluster:

Chairman is appointed by the President with Board approval. This committee is in charge of the Annual Spring show, including applying for the AKC approval of show dates & judges, ring stewards, trophies, working with the Cluster coordinator and the other cluster clubs. This committee involves a great deal of work before the show dates as well as the show weekend. They will compile the premium list information, arrange for trophy purchase and donations, local catalog advertising sales, local publicity, etc. This committee is comprised of several smaller sub-committees that deal only with the Wichita show, i.e. ring stewards, trophies, local advertising & publicity, house & grounds, crating, catalog ads, catalog sales, hospitality, security, telephone, speakers stand, etc.

(Budget: Self-Funding)

**SUNFLOWER CLUSTER COORDINATOR:** The Coordinator is appointed by the President with the Board approval. The coordinator is responsible for the things that affect all four (4) clubs in the Sunflower Cluster, maintaining a good working relationship with the KS Pavilions staff, being sure our dates are reserved well in advance & that all the building arrangements have been made. Is responsible for the appointment of the committees chosen from all four clubs. The list of committees should be presented at the August meeting for approval by the Cluster clubs. The committees include but are not limited to: Judges' liaison, General Facilities (Crating, Building, Grounds & Sanitation), Security & Parking, National Advertising, National Publicity, Cluster Hospitality, Agility Exhibitions, AKC Information Booth, Cluster Vendors or Booths, Breed Seminars & Committee Parking. The Cluster coordinator interfaces with the Art Show at the Dog Show Chairperson, Show Veterinarian, Show Photographer, etc., sets the dates for the Cluster meeting and distributes the agendas for the cluster meetings to the appropriate persons. Submits the portion of the Premium list that deals with Cluster activities and its special events. Cluster committee information as required to the Superintendent in a timely fashion accordingly to our deadlines. (Budget: copy work, postage, supplies for cluster as needed.)

October 26, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 PM. In Attendance: Treva Faires, Pat Deshler, Tom Chase, Mike Williams, Kim Jennings, Dianne Kilts, and Arleen Berry

The September WKC Board Meeting Minutes were accepted.

**Corresponding Secretary:** Pat Deshler presented a newsletter from The Museum of the Dog (Siris) containing an article written by one of the 2012 Art Show at the Dog Show jurors, Jerry Berger.

Pat also received in the mail a solicitation from KSDS for donations to the construction of their campus.

Received also were both the October and November newsletters from Hutchinson Kennel Club, "The Bow Wow."

The AKC newsletter "Taking Command" was received via e-mail by the WKC Corresponding Secretary, Pat Deshler.

**Treasurer:** Tom Chase presented the WKC monthly Balance Sheet, Profit & Loss Statement and Cash Transactions Report. Included were the Preliminary Report of the Wheatland Cluster Fall Show (WKC show only) and the Final Report of the 2011 Sunflower Cluster Spring Show (WKC show only) which reflects the refunded reserve deposit from Onofrio which was received in October.

**Membership:** Treva Faires reported that there are three prospective members who have fulfilled their volunteer activities. Pat Mitchell, Joanne Fletcher, and Patricia Holmes are prospective WKC members.

**Conformation Classes:** Treva Faires reported there are currently no classes going on at this time.

**Art Show:** Pat Deshler reported that ASATDS has chosen two jurors for the 2012 Spring Show: Jerry Berger of Springfield, MO and Susan Grinels of Lander, WY. Pat also presented preliminary copies of the "Call for Entries" information sheets that will be mailed out after the Sunflower Cluster Meeting on October 30th in Hutchinson, KS at 2:00 PM.

**AKC Delegate:** Treva Faires reported there are currently no new topics being discussed among AKC delegates. She still plans to attend the AKC Delegate's meeting in December in Orlando, FL.

**Old Business:**

The WKC committee appointed to replace David Crump's position on the board presented a nomination to appoint Mike Williams to move into David's position as Vice President and to nominate Bev Benjes to join the WKC Board as a member. The WKC Board voted to accept the committee's recommendation.

**New Business:**

The WKC Board appointed a committee to explore the possibility of having a "Meet the Breeds" sometime in the Spring of 2012, since the Wichita Lawn and Garden Show has come under new management and we will not be able to hold it in conjunction with that event. Mike Williams will chair the committee with Dianne Kilts and Arleen Berry as committee members.

**SCART:** Treva Faires reported that SCART (Sedgwick County Animal Rescue) would like to use the WKC building for a meeting on Sunday, November 20th. There were no objections from the WKC Board members so the meeting will be held.

The Wheatland Golden Retriever Club would like to hold a breed seminar at the 2012 Sunflower Cluster--preferably on Friday, April 6th. Grounds Chairperson, Mike Williams said they could section off an area in Pavilion II for them to do this. Kim Jennings will follow up with Julie Speer of the WGRC.

### Program Introduction

The AKC New Exhibitor Mentoring Program is designed to help recent registrants of AKC dogs or those thinking about getting an AKC registered dog meet experienced dog fanciers and breeders to assist them in getting started. These seasoned handlers and exhibitors will share their expertise with those expressing an interest in entering the exciting world of AKC competition.

How it works:

When you submit a [signed application](#) we will send you a list of qualified mentors located in your state. These mentors have the experience necessary to get you started regardless of what breed you have. They will provide you with such tools as:

- Basic Dog Show/Event Etiquette
- Dog Show/Event Judging Procedures
- Understanding Common Show/Event Terms
- Types of Events
- How to Fill Out An Entry Form
- How to join a dog club in your area

Mentoring has a long history with AKC and relationships developed this way have often lasted lifetimes. Who knows, perhaps someday it will come full circle and you will be mentoring a new exhibitor in the years to come!

Meeting a fellow dog enthusiast is exciting, especially when you share a common interest in showing dogs or a specific breed. First meetings are perfectly safe, but it's always smart to take basic precautions. Always trust your instincts. And be sure to keep the following guidelines in mind:

DO meet in public. Your first meeting should be arranged to meet in a public place. We suggest that a dog show or a club meeting is an excellent place to arrange for a first meeting.

DON'T ask the Mentee or Mentor to pick you up and don't offer to drive the Mentee or Mentor to your first meeting.

DO be wary of someone who is vague, talks in circles or answers questions with other questions.

The American Kennel Club does not supervise these meetings and is not involved in any way with the actions of any individuals at these meetings. As a result, we have no control over the identity or actions of the individuals who are present at these meetings. We request that those using this program exercise caution and good judgment when meeting prospective Mentors or Mentees.
