The Scent Work Premium List for the Cluster has been up for several weeks, and entries are open.

Answers to some questions:

Yes, we are crating out of our vehicles except for volunteers and judges.

Containers, interiors, and novice and advanced handler discrimination will be located in the Encampment Building, which is air conditioned, on the second floor. There is an elevator.

Bring pop up tents, fans, and shade cloths to help keep you and your dogs cool. Efficient running of the elements will avoid the heat of the day. The club will have pop up tents over the check in area.

Parking for most exhibitors will be across 23rd Street on grass. There will be handicapped parking on gravel near the Encampment Building.

Bathrooms are located inside the building as well as a public restroom building directly west of the Encampment Building.
