Jackie Storrer – President – Mike Williams chaired the meeting for Jackie. Mike called the meeting to order and asked if everyone had seen last month's meeting minutes. All said they had. Leanne Chase moved that we accept last month's minutes as published. Charlotte Norris seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mike Williams, Corresponding Secretary – Mike said the only e-mails he had received were with regards to the upcoming FastCAT trial to be held at the Williams' farm on September 24 and 25. Other e-mails were in regards to the Total Dog Day to be held on September 14 at the Kansas State Fair Grounds, the scent trial on November 11-13, and the CGC classes that have now started by Lori Hays.
