2023 MEET THE BREEDS KANSAS STATE FAIRGROUNDS

The annual Meet the Breeds will be at the Kansas State Fair. Please contact Mike Williams as soon as possible so he can plan and get tickets for you to get into the fairgrounds. After you unload your equipment, you will have to park off the fairgrounds. Mike can get a few parking places for people to park, but he can't get a lot of them. He would like to reserve those for people who have issues walking, if possible.

Where: Expo Arena Building, located in the SE corner of the fairgrounds.

When: Wednesday, September 13, 2023 – 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon Members do not have to stay the whole 1/2 day. We will be flexible.

Who: Contact Mike Williams at md7williams@cox.net to let him know what breeds, time frame you would like to participate, and how many tables you will need.

All dogs should be four months of age or older, and if they are four months, then bring an adult dog with you.

Participants should bring their breed standard in writing so it can be handed out to the public for information. Information on your kennel might be helpful as well. Also, you are encouraged to bring battery powered fans.

As in the past, if your breed club has a banner or handouts specific to your club, bring those items for display.

You will be allowed to enter the fairgrounds through Gates E-9 or E-10 and pull up to the Expo Arena building to unload your dogs and equipment, but your vehicle must be driven back to the public parking area across Plum Street. (See attached State Fairground map.)

Dogs will only be allowed in the Expo Arena and not anywhere else on the fairgrounds. There are plenty of grassy areas to potty your dogs. Bring plastic bags to pick up poop.
