ENTRY METHOD: First received mailed entries or online entries.

ENTRIES WILL OPEN ON August 19th, 2024 at 9:00AM CDT at the Trial Secretary's address listed in this premium or entries can be made online at this [link](#). The online entry link will be activated when entries open. Entry fees must be paid in full for your entry to be valid. All entries received before this date will be returned. Online entries will be subject to a convenience fee. All mail such as Overnight, Certified or Priority, whether USPS, FedEx, UPS or any other such delivery service must be sent with the "No Signature Required" waiver signed. All entries must be on the official AKC entry form and signed by the owner. This includes emailed entries. Illegible entries will not be accepted. Please print clearly or use the computer generated entry form.

PRE-ENTRIES CLOSE ON September 23rd, 2024 at 9:00PM CDT after which time any entry received will be considered a post closing entry and subject to the fee schedule for day of event entries.

Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

ENTRIES LIMITED TO 100 runs per test (maximum of 200 per day)

Day-Of-Entries will be accepted if the limit has not been reached on the day of the test. Day-of entries should plan to arrive by 2PM Friday and 11AM Saturday and Sunday. Please keep in mind, day-of entries will run at the end of the day, unless time permits.

Awards:

Each dog completing the 100 yard dash will receive a flat qualifying ribbon.

Fastest time in each height division for each test will receive a rosette.

Fastest Non-Sighthound in each class will receive a rosette.

Fastest for each breed with more than 6 entries before close of pre-entry will receive a rosette.

Additional awards available for fastest of any breed with more than 10 pre-entries.

Dogs completing their BCAT title will receive a 12 inch rosette, dogs completing their DCAT title will receive an 18 inch rosette and dogs completing their FCAT title will receive a 22 inch rosette!

ELIGIBLE DOGS: FastCAT is open to dogs 12 months of age or older. All dogs must be individually registered with the AKC. This includes all AKC registered purebreds, Foundation Stock Service (FSS), Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), and AKC Canine Partners.

Dogs not yet listed with the AKC Canine Partners (CP) program are eligible once forms and fees are submitted. The easiest way to complete this is through the online form on the AKC website for Canine Partners. Forms to have a dog listed with CP will be also available at the event. The fee for listing a dog with CP is \$19 and is in addition to entry fees.

Spayed or neutered dogs, or dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.

Bitches in season are not eligible to run. A refund (minus convenience fees and AKC recording fee) will be issued for BIS withdrawn after the closing date. Notification *in writing* must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first run of the day of the trial.

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES: No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the host club or organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or banned from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Any entries pulled in writing (email/mail) prior to entry closing will be refunded (minus any convenience fees). Any entries pulled after closing will not be refunded.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

1. Entries will **NOT** be accepted without fees and signatures on the “Agreement” found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
2. Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog’s physical strength. All dogs will be inspected by members of the Event Committee. The Committee has the authority to disallow a dog’s entry. Bitches in season, lame, overweight, or out of condition dogs will be refused entry at inspection. A refund (minus AKC recording fee and any convenience fees) will be given for dogs refused entry. An owner can substitute another of their own dogs if a dog is not allowed due to BIS, injury, or being unfit.
3. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available.
4. Run order will be based on order set by the field committee. We will have workers available to help release multiple dogs owned by one handler. We will also have workers outside the run out area ready to receive those dogs and hold them so the owner can personally catch all of them. If a dog is late for their run time they will run at the end of the running order for that flight.
5. Muzzles are allowed. Head halters are allowed (but not in the run/start area). No pinch collars, and no electronic training collars or devices are allowed. The club recommends using a plain buckle collar and lead. No flexi leads will be allowed for safety reasons. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of getting hung up on something during the run or your dog can run naked (without a collar). Owners should be aware that there is a chance the tags hanging from the collar could become entangled on something during the run, so please use a collar without tags. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog’s hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog with regard to the dog’s collar and paraphernalia on the dog. Dogs are allowed to run with no collar – however, a dog that cannot be caught for an excessive amount of time (causing a delay in the event) may be assessed a \$5 fine, per occurrence.

6. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
7. The Hunt Master is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
8. Any decisions made by the event's officials regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the event officials to withhold any and all qualifications.
9. No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
10. Persons exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct or conduct detrimental to the WKC and any dog(s) or other person(s) will be asked to leave the event site and may be subject to further disciplinary action.
11. Dogs engaged with the lure but not completing the 100 yard course will be excused for that test.
12. Dogs not on course must be on leash and under control at all times – this will be strictly enforced.
13. There will be a minimum \$30 returned check charge.
14. A \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the trial in progress.
15. A \$5 fine will be assessed for any handler not cleaning up after their dog.
16. A \$5 fine will be assessed for anyone littering or leaving trash on the property.
17. WKC reserves the right to alter the course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the trial.
18. Children must be accompanied by an adult and under supervision at all times.
19. Only the Lure Operator, Hunt Master, and Handler of the dog running the trial will be permitted near the lure machine.
20. The event-hosting Wichita Kennel Club and its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, and property owners assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
21. *****NEW AKC RULE***** - Any dog that eliminates on course will receive a non-qualifying (NQ) score.

22. WHAT IF MY DOG IS SICK THAT DAY? Please do not bring a sick, or lame dog, or a female in-season, to this event. Email the Secretary and cancel your entry at least 30 min prior to the start of the test.

23. Non-AKC registered dogs can enroll in AKC's Canine Partners program or are welcome to run "fun-runs" at the end of the day, or as time permits. Fun-runs *do not* count for points or titles.

DIRECTIONS TO EVENT SITE: 7277 N Hillside, Park City, KS 67147

From the North or South: I-135 to Exit 14 (Park City / 61st Street North) This exit is north of the city of Wichita. East on 61st St N to Hillside. North on Hillside to Williams Farm at 7277 N Hillside (west / left side of the road) The entrance has large "W" signs, an arena building is visible from the road.

From the East: 254 to Woodlawn / Kechi Exit – you will take 61st Go straight West on 61st St to Hillside, turn right (North) on Hillside.

From the East: K96 to Hillside exit. North on Hillside to 7277 N Hillside.

From the West I-235, exit to I-135 North (Salina) – Once on I-135, you will use 61st St N exit as described above. (If the exit is closed due to construction, use exit to 254. Then north on Hillside).

PARKING:

Please follow signs and park in designated parking areas. Failure to do so may result in being stuck and tow charges. Please *do not* park on the grass in front of the residence.
