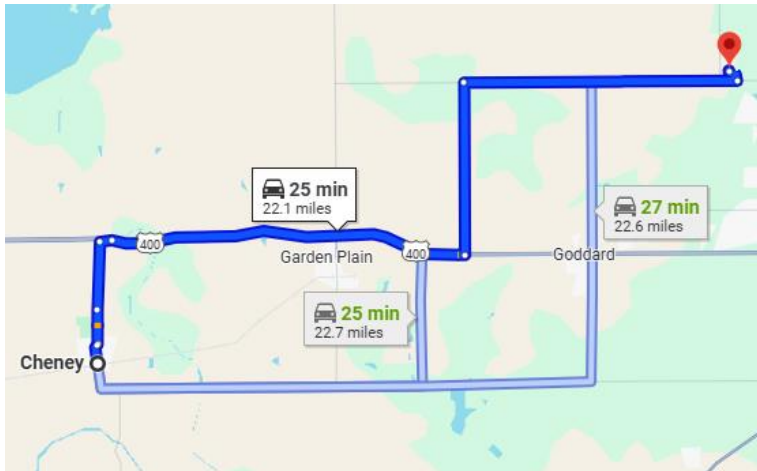

HANDLER DISCRIMINATION DIVISION

Handler Discrimination classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handlers themselves. Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag: for the Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock, for Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs. Three qualifying scores are required to earn title in each class.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

ENTRY FEES

*An entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class.
Entry fees include a \$3.50 per run AKC recording fee.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax, or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$30.00 collection fee added to the amount of each returned check.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

Wichita Kennel Club is **NOT** offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. All entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and time. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on March 7, 2025, at 8:00 PM CST, (exceptions may apply).

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). The staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

Warm-up area: The club shall designate a warm-up area. One labeled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search Area Conditions. Searches may be indoors, on matted, tarped, carpeted, astroturf, concrete, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.

Search Area Sizes may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors starting Friday, March 21, 2025, at 7:00 AM. No dogs to be left overnight. Dogs and equipment must be removed from the show site on Sunday, March 23, 2025.

Parking. All parking is in the designated parking lot next to the 4-H Building.

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectator Area. Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed a run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area if space permits and the judge approves. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search until the completion of the class.

Crating will be available inside the 4-H Building. Please provide a mat or ground cover on the floor beneath all crates. Crates may be left overnight; however, the Wichita Kennel Club and Sedgwick County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund, if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Placement flat ribbons will be awarded in each Novice through Master class as follows:

<i>First Place</i>	<i>Blue</i>

<i>Fourth Place</i>	<i>White</i>

A **New Element & Level Title Rosette** will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

An **Elite Element & Elite Level Title Rosette** will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing an Elite title.

A **Master Title Medal** will be awarded to dog and handler teams finishing a Master title.

A **High-in-Trial Rosette**: Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, Buried), and qualify in each are eligible to win **High-in-Trial**. One High-In-Trial winner is chosen per difficulty level; there is no separate High-in-Trial for the Novice A and Novice B sections.

A **High-in-Trial Combined (HCD) Rosette**: Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, Buried) plus Handler Discrimination, and qualify in each, are eligible to win High Combined Division. One High-In-Trial winner is chosen per difficulty level; there is no separate HCD for the Novice A and Novice B sections.

Rising Star Rosette: Offered to teams participating at the Novice A level in all elements offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, Buried) and must qualify in all elements to be eligible to win a Rising Star Rosette. Scores from each element run in Novice A on each trial day will be added to determine the highest scoring Star.

High Scoring Junior Gift Certificate (Value \$65): Scores from each element (Container, Interior, Exterior, Buried) run at the Novice, Advanced, Excellent, or Master level on each trial day will be added to determine the highest scoring junior. Gift certificate sponsored by the Wichita Kennel Club to apply toward WKC Scent Work classes, trial entries, and/or workshops.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Wichita Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Wichita Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Wichita Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must always be on leash, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. A refund, minus any convenience fees and/or AKC fees will be issued. We require a veterinarian letter/certificate to confirm the female is in season one hour before the trial starts.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: At check-in all exhibitors will pick up their armband number(s). Check-in is open from 8:00 to 8:30 AM each day.

RUN ORDERS! AKC Rule – Run and class orders must be available to competitors by midnight the night BEFORE the trial! We will determine run and class orders for the next day prior to the trial, with that information contained in the final confirmation email, and any changes in class or level order will be sent to exhibitors before midnight of the day before said change.

Day of Trial Run Orders will be posted before briefings at the trial site each morning of each trial.

Individual run order will generally follow armband number with changes made for conflicts or unique consideration. Please stay flexible! Minor changes in individual run orders may occur to facilitate workers or judges getting to their stations!

Exhibitors MUST check in EACH day they are entered.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

March weather in Kansas can be changeable – rain, wind, snow, and freezing temperatures may be experienced at any time. Please be prepared for variability.

“Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.”

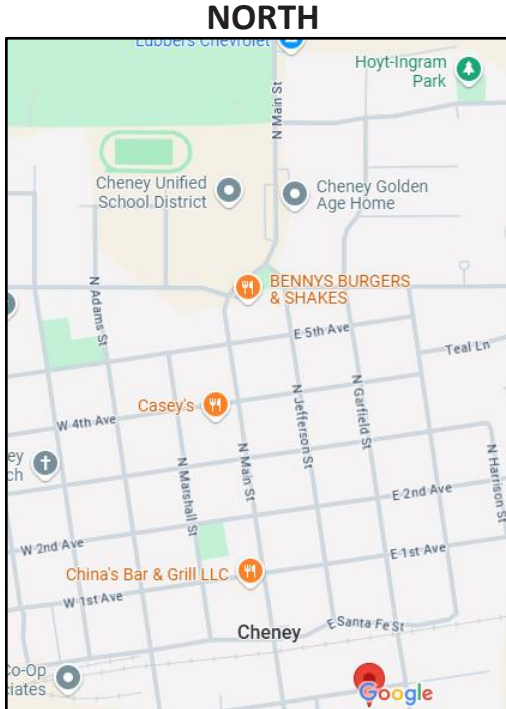
